Application for the 2009-2010 Academic Year



The Jobs and Education for Texans (JET) Grant Program was created to provide tuition grants to eligible Texas colleges to award scholarships to students enrolled in a training program for high-demand occupations, such as:

- Business and Computer Information Systems,
- Commercial Construction Program,
- Computer Drafting Technology,
- Computer Networking/Troubleshooting,
- Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning,
- Instrumentation Technology,
- Occupational Safety and Health,
- Process Operating Technology,
- Utility Line Technology,
- Advanced Engine Technology,
- Industrial Mechanics Technology,
- Welding Technology,
- Cardiovascular Sonography,
- Dental Hygiene,
- Diagnostic Medical Sonography,
- Emergency Medical Services,
- Health Information Technology,
- Radiologic Technology, and
- Respiratory Care.

Lamar Institute of Technology received \$32,927 in JET Grant funds for the 2009-2010 Academic Year and plans to award all of these funds for the Spring 2010 semester. To that end, the JET Scholarship Committee has compiled a checklist to ensure that you are eligible to apply for a JET Grant.

To be Eligible an LIT Student:

- ✓ Must demonstrate financial need on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
- ✓ Must be permanent legal residents of the United States and have established Texas Residency;
- ✓ Must be enrolled or are enrolling in one of LIT's training program for a high-demand occupation as determined by the Comptroller.
- ✓ Must complete the JET Application Process between November 2, 2009 and December 2, 2009, including a properly signed "*State of Texas Jobs and Education for Texans (JET) Scholarship Application and Release*" form.
- ✓ Must sign in and use the Official Student LIT E-mail address as this will be the primary method by which LIT will communicate with students.

Students receiving a scholarship under this subchapter may only use the scholarship funds to pay for tuition and fees, including lab fees and exam or certification fees, for qualifying training programs for high-demand occupations as determined by the Comptroller.
