PROCEDURE LIT.8.13.02 TUITION AND FEE DEFERMENT FOR VETERANS EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE

SCOPE: Faculty, Staff, and Students

All qualified individuals are covered to attend or participate in a course of education, pending VA payment, providing the individual submits a certificate of eligibility for entitlement to educational assistance and is therefore in compliance with the requirements of 38 U.S. Code Section 3679(e) and Section 103, Public Law 115-407.

- 1.1. Tuition and fees may be deferred once per term for up to 90 days.
 - 1.1.1. Excluded fees:
 - 1.1.1.1. Books
 - 1.1.1.2. Supplies
 - 1.1.2. Deferments must be paid by the due date regardless of whether benefit payments have been received or posted to the student's account.
 - 1.1.2.1. As a result, the student will be responsible for any debt this may create to the school and training provider.
- 1.2. Qualified individuals who defer payments may not be:
 - 1.2.1. Required to borrow additional funds
 - 1.2.2. Penalized by late fees
 - 1.2.3. Denied access to classes, library, or other institutional facilities
