POLICY LIT.8.13 VETERAN SERVICES

SCOPE: Students

Additionally, LIT assists students in utilizing the Texas Hazelwood Exemption Act, which provides tuition and fee exemptions for eligible Texas Veterans.

Lamar Institute of Technology is committed to assisting eligible U.S. military and veteran students who are using Veteran Affairs benefits to further their education. It is the policy of LIT to abide by Federal and State rules and regulations governing the administration of Veteran benefits.
